1.	Understanding the timeline
	☐ Allow 6–12 months from offer to completion.
	☐ Expect possible delays during holidays or busy periods.
	☐ Include a time buffer in your planning.
2.	Experiencing both seasons
	☐ Visit Corfu in both summer and winter before deciding.
	☐ Check access to shops, schools, and transport year-round.
	☐ Consider how quiet life becomes off-season.
	Consider now quiet life becomes on season.
3.	Taxes, accounting & paperwork
	☐ Hire a trusted local accountant early.
	☐ If you will be renting, review short-term rental regulations.
4.	Renovation & building rules
	☐ Consult a local engineer before any work starts.
	☐ Check zoning and permit status in advance.
	☐ Confirm all documents and approvals are valid.
5.	Communication & legal clarity
	☐ Avoid informal agreements without your lawyer/agent.
	☐ Ensure all arrangements are clearly documented (the best – via emails).
	☐ Keep your professional team updated on each step.
6.	Planning property viewings
	☐ Book all viewings in advance, especially in high season.
	☐ Account for long driving distances and local holidays.
	☐ Leave flexibility for follow-up visits or extra checks.
7.	Choosing the right partners
	☐ Work only with transparent and established agencies.
	☐ Confirm all 'buildable' plots with a qualified engineer.
	☐ Partner with a lawyer who represents your interests.
	☐ Choose professionals who communicate clearly and provide written updates.
